These initiatives are designed with specific enough direction in the area of priestly care to create immediate impact, while left flexible enough to continue to address the needs of the future.

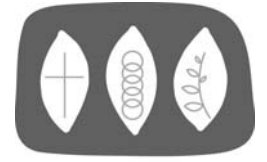
Quick Facts
