Faith Alive Education Committee Sets Process in Motion

The Faith Alive education committee, at its second meeting on September 11, outlined and began the process it will follow to establish a Catholic school system for the greater Green Bay area.

The first step of the process will be to assess critical attributes such as curriculum, finances, physical assets, etc. of the proposed school system by collecting and updating data related to these attributes and formulating that data into three or four workable models. Once these models have been proposed, they will be presented for parish feedback in a series of parish cluster meetings. The committee will then review all input it has received and determine the two most feasible models. At that point, parishes will have a second opportunity to supply the committee with its responses

After the committee has considered this feedback, the best model for the Catholic school system for the greater Green Bay area will be selected. Parish input will again be sought for the implementation phase.

“It is essential that this project be built through ongoing grassroots discussion at the parish level”, says Mark Salisbury, diocesan superintendent of schools and temporary coordinator of the project.

During the September 11 meeting, the committee also discussed other considerations, such as the timeline, leadership changes, project constraints, challenges and assumptions. The committee agreed it will work on these

issues in an ongoing manner.

The Faith Alive education committee is scheduled to meet on October 9 and November 13. Progress reports will be issued for parishes to include as bulletin inserts. Information will also be available on the diocesan website, www.gbdioc.org, and the diocesan newspaper, *The Compass*.
