INVITATION:

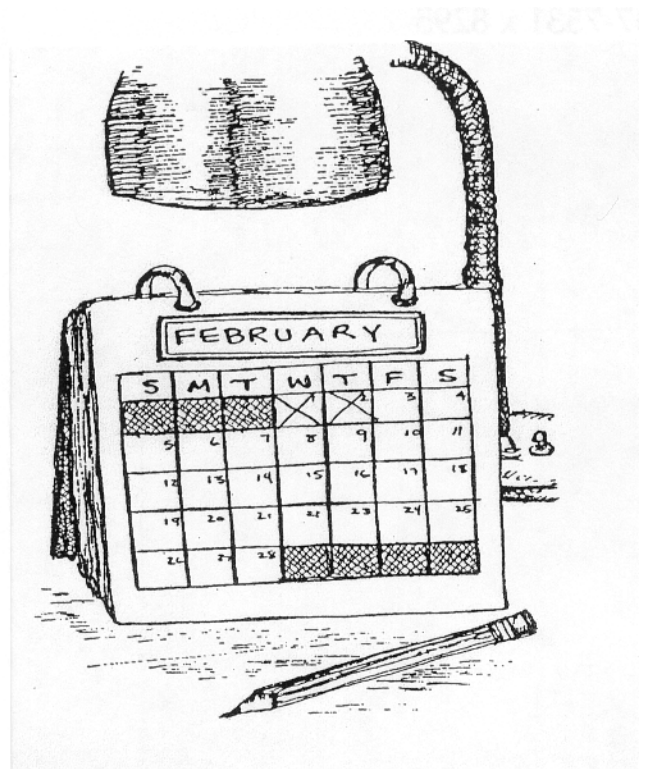
In the months and years ahead, every family will know both good times and hard times. How can your family make the best of all the times that are to come?
